Another Secret Document: Matsumuro's Memorandum

In September 1936, a report allegedly submitted by Major General Takayoshi Matsumuro to the Kwantung Army Conference was published in The China Weekly Review and then in Pravda the following year, and was cited by Zhu De and Mao Zedong after 1938. This document, which argued for the importance of northern China with a view to Manchuria and Mongolia, was positioned as a mysterious document "Tanaka Memorial" that showed "Japan's policy" and was used for propaganda. This paper is based on a part written in History of Spies During the Japanese Invasion published in 1938.
